570 AD

- Born
- went to Halima Sadia

576 AD

- came back
- Mother died during trip to Yathrib
- Umm-e-Aiman brought back
- Under Abdul-Mutallib's care
- got love and affection

578 AD

- Abdul-Mutallib died
- Abu Talib took responsibility
- treated him better than his own sons
- recieved no formal education

579 AD --- onwards

- showed signs of an intelligent and inquisitive mind
- kived solitude, no indulgence in playful activities
- loved by people for sweet and peaceful nature

582 AD

- Accompanied Abu Talib to Syria
- Trade trip
- Met Bahira, monk
- Saw signs of prophethood
- advised not to go further (fear of jews etc)

585 AD

- Sacreligious War fought
- Harb-ul-Fijar
- No Active participation
- helped uncles indirectly
- disturbed peaceful nature of mind
- developed strong dislike for war

- got military experience

- Half-al-Fazul formed

- joined it

- greatly impressed

Al-Sadiq and Al-Amin

- honesty

- truthfulness

- entrusted

- before/after prophethood

595 AD

- Sent to Syria for trade by Khadija

- with Maisera

- honest result

- proposed marriage

- accepted

- Best wife

605 AD

- Fixing of Black Stone (story)

610 AD

- Call to Prophet (whole cave of Hira event)

610 AD --- 613 AD

- Began Preaching

- Privately

- known friends, Abu Bakr etc

- Kindred, rejected at meal- except Ali

613 AD --- onwards

- Revelation

- Orders to Preach Openly

- Safa Incident

- rejected his claim

- Abu Jahl, insulting remarks

- Preached at public and private gatherings

- Approach routes to Makkah

- Efforts successful
- People began accepting Islam
- Opposition began
- By Quraish
- disliked new religion
- did not want change in their practices
- threatened their position and importance
- danger to dignity and prestige
- considered Prophet from less influential tribe
- Nor had riches, power etc

- Private preaching
- silent and safe
- no opposition
- confined followers
- public preaching began
- opposition began
- Influtential people hostile
- leaders
- abu jahl, lahb, sufyan, walid bin mugaira and atba bin rabi
- Poor,weak and slaves tortured
- Blal, Ammar bin Yasir etc
- Beaten with sticks
- exposed to scorching heat
- given alternative
- choose islam
- some died
- rich also not spared-Abu Bakr, Usman, Talha etc
- Prophet
- Opposition increased gradually
- rubbish-dumb, filth thrown on him
- abuses hurled
- jahl placed filth, Fatima removed

- once, was strangled while at the Kaabah
- poetry written against
- called a poet, madman and a magician
- lahab's sons divorced two daughters
- called him abtar
- faced everthing with patience, preservance and determination

- failed

- failed
- Banu Hashim pledged protection to Prophet

Migration

- Abyssinya
- Permission after seeing hardships
- first-11 men--4 women
- second-79 men--7 women
- Quraish went
- tried/failed (Najashi event)

Boycott

- Pagans upset
- growing influence
- Umar, Hamza etc in Islam
- Najashi protection

617 AD

- Total Social and economic boycott
- By Quraish
- agreement hung into Ka'abah
- Whole Tribe lived in Shib Abi Talib
- Excluded from all social and commercial activities
- Extreme difficulties
- No food/drink

- Children hungry
- Adults fed on boiled leather
- Respite given
- only for sacred/pilgrimage months
- Continued for three years

620 AD

- Boycott lifted, felt sympathy
- Am-ul-Hazn, (death of Khadija and Abu Talib)
- lost protection
- married Sawdah
- married Ayesha

Same Year

- Visit Taif
- with Zaid bin Haris
- faced rejection
- chased by teenagers
- shouted abuses
- threw stones
- wounded
- shoes filled with blood
- zaid's head wounded
- protecting the Prophet
- sought refuge in a garden
- Angel came
- asked permission for destruction
- denied, forgave and prayed for them

621 AD

- six pilgrims from Yasrib
- Khazraj Tribe
- Invited, accepted Islam

622 AD

- 12 people came
- met Aqaba

-pledged. 1st Pledge

623 AD

-75 people came

-Pledged

-Invited Prophet

Same Year

-Migration

-one by one, all companions

-Abu Bakr, Ali and Prophet left

-Quraish plotted to kill

-Prophet and Abu Bakr left secretly

-Quraish fooled

-Ali stayed back-Return valuables entrusted to Prophet-left later

-Both went-stayed at Saur

-Daughter/Son/Guide

-Cave miracles (web, eggs etc)

-Went to Quba-met Ali

-first mosque-first friday sermon
